The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed widening of N.C. 16 (Providence Road) from Rea Road (S.R. 1316) to Waxhaw Parkway (S.R. 3530) in Union County. The primary purpose of this project is to reduce congestion along N.C. 16.
