

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING
FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT TO
MAIN STREET (S.R. 1009) & I-85 INTERCHANGE
RANDOLPH COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to improve Main Street (S.R. 1009) and the Main Street / I-85 interchange within the City of Archdale. The meeting will take place on Thursday, November 30, 2017 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Open Door Baptist Church located at 135 W. White Drive in Archdale.

Proposed improvements include reconfiguring the interchange as well as adding a raised median and sidewalks on Main Street from Columbus Avenue to Commanche Road. An alternative frontage road is also proposed to extend west from Balfour Drive between businesses, ending at Main Street with a new signal near the U.S. Post Office. The purpose of this project is to reduce congestion along Main Street, especially at the I-85 interchange ramps, as well as to improve traffic safety.

The public may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by December 22, 2017. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
