

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING ON NOV. 16 FOR TWO PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS
ALONG WHITE STREET (S.R. 1170) AND N.C. 225 (SOUTH MAIN STREET)
IN HENDERSON COUNTY**

STIP PROJECT NOS. U-5886 AND U-6049

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting in November regarding two proposed projects to make improvements to White Street (S.R. 1170) and N.C. 225 (South Main Street) in Henderson County.

Project U-5886 proposes to realign and extend White Street (S.R. 1170) from Willow Road (S.R. 1171) to U.S. 176 (Spartanburg Highway). Included in this project is to replace Bridge over Mud Creek (Bridge 229).

Project U-6049 proposes to widen the Bridge over Mud Creek (Bridge 143) to five lanes along N.C. 225 from South King Street to U.S. 176.

A public meeting will be held at **Hendersonville City Operational Center located at 305 Williams Street on Thursday, November 16th from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.**

The purpose of this meeting is to inform the public of the project and gather public input on the proposed design.

The public may attend at any time during the public meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments. Comments and information received will be taken into consideration as work on the project develops. Written comments or questions can also be submitted at the meeting or later by November 30, 2017. Please note that there will not be a formal presentation.
