

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING ON JAN. 18 REGARDING THE PROPOSED
IMPROVEMENTS TO THE INTERSECTION OF N.C. 55 / DOCTOR M.L.K. JR. BLVD IN
CRAVEN COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation (NCDOT) proposes to improve the existing intersection of N.C. 55 / Doctor M.L.K. Jr. Blvd by converting the intersection to a roundabout.

A public meeting will be held at **Grover C. Fields Middle School located at 2000 Doctor M.L. King Jr. Blvd on Thursday, February 8th from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.**

The purpose of this meeting is to inform the public of the project and gather public input on the proposed design. Maps of the study area, environmental features and proposed designs will be available on the project website for public review and comment.

The public may attend at any time during the public meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments. Comments and information received will be taken into consideration as work on the project develops. Written comments or questions can also be submitted at the meeting or later by February 22, 2018. Please note that there will not be a formal presentation.
