The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed intersection improvements to South Church Street (U.S. 70) in Burlington. The meeting will be held on August 16 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Grove Park Baptist Church Fellowship Hall located at 108 Trail One in Burlington.

State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Project No. U-6010 proposes to improve the intersection at University Drive (S.R. 1226/S.R. 1311) and widen College Road from 1000 feet west of the University Drive intersection to Westbrook Avenue. STIP Project No. U-6011 proposes to improve the intersection at Huffman Mill Road (S.R. 1158)/Shadowbrook Drive with additional improvements along Shadowbrook Drive from Neese Court to Colonial Drive.

The purpose of these two projects, which are being planned together, is to improve traffic operations by providing additional capacity, and improve pedestrian and bicycle access.
