The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to realign the intersection of N.C. 56 (East C Street) and West Lyon Station Road (S.R. 1215) in Butner. The meeting will take place on Tuesday, February 27, 2018 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Butner Town Hall, Camp Butner Room located at 415 Central Avenue.

The purpose of the public meeting will be to gather input from the public on the preliminary design for this project.

The public may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by March 14, 2018. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops.
