The N.C. Department of Transportation proposes to construct a roundabout on Mineral Springs Road (S.R. 1917/1815) at Pleasant Drive (S.R. 1815) in Durham. The purpose of this project is to improve the safety of the Mineral Springs Road/Pleasant Drive intersection and the curve along Mineral Springs Road. This project is in the planning stage and is not currently funded.

Purpose of Tonight's Meeting


