

**NCDOT TO HOST A PUBLIC MEETING IN JUNE FOR THE PROPOSED  
AIRPORT PARKWAY FROM U.S. 70/U.S. 601 (JAKE ALEXANDER BOULEVARD)  
NEAR BRENNER AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF CEDAR SPRINGS ROAD, U.S. 29,  
AND PEELER ROAD IN SALISBURY, ROWAN COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation is proposing construct a road, part on new location, from U.S. 70/U.S. 601 (Jake Alexander Boulevard) near Brenner Avenue to the intersection of Cedar Springs Road, U.S. 29, and Peeler Road in Salisbury. The public meeting will be held at the **Salisbury Civic Center** located at **315 S. Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue**, in **Salisbury**, on **Tuesday, June 12<sup>th</sup>** from **4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

The purpose of this meeting is to provide interested citizens with information on the project and gather public input on the proposed design.

Interested citizens may attend at any time between 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Please note that there will not be a formal presentation. NCDOT representatives will display maps and be available to answer questions and receive comments. Comments and information received will be taken into consideration as work on the project develops. Written comments or questions can also be submitted at the meeting or later by **June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018**.
