

**NCDOT TO HOST A PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING THE PROPOSED WIDENING OF FIRE  
TOWER ROAD (S.R. 1708) AND PORTERTOWN ROAD (S.R. 1726)  
IN GREENVILLE**

**STIP Project No. U-5870 and No. U-5785**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold an open-house public meeting regarding the proposed widening of Fire Tower Road (S.R. 1708) and Portertown Road (S.R. 1726), from N.C. 43 (Charles Boulevard) to N.C. 33 (10th Street) in the City of Greenville. The meeting will take place on Monday, July 31, 2017 at the **Pitt County Community Schools and Recreation Building** at **Alice Keene Park**, located at **4561 County Home Road** in **Greenville** from **4p.m. to 7p.m.**

The purpose of the meeting is to provide information about modifications that have been made to the project designs since September 2016, including improvements to the adjacent Charles Boulevard/ Fire Tower Road intersection and Arlington Boulevard/Fire Tower Road intersection, and the street network surrounding these intersections.

Interested citizens are encouraged to attend at any time during those hours. NCDOT and Consultant staff will be available to provide information on the project, answer questions and receive comments. Please note there will be no formal presentation.
