FOR PROPOSED N.C. 84 IMPROVEMENTS [REA ROAD (S.R. 1316) EXTENSION] FROM N.C. 16 TO WAXHAW-INDIAN TRAIL ROAD (S.R. 1008) IN WESLEY CHAPEL AND PROPOSED CONVERSION OF PARKS AND RECREATION TRUST FUND ASSISTED PROPERTY AT DOGWOOD PARK IN WESLEY CHAPEL UNION COUNTY

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed extension of Rea Road (S.R. 1316) from N.C. 16 (Providence Road) east to Weddington Road (N.C. 84) on new location and then widen existing N.C. 84 to Waxhaw-Indian Trail Road (S.R. 1008), in Wesley Chapel. The new location roadway would be signed as N.C. 84. The meeting will take place on Tuesday June 20, 2017 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Graceway Baptist Church, located at 4700 Monroe-Weddington Road in Matthews.

The proposed project would convert around 0.73 of an acre along N.C. 84 at Dogwood Park, a Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (PARTF) grant-assisted property, from parkland to transportation use. The N.C. Department of Natural and Cultural Resources approved mitigation of U-3467 impacts to Dogwood Park is required in the form of suitable replacement property.

The primary purpose of the project is to improve the mobility and connectivity of N.C. 84 in the project study area.

The public may attend at any time during the hours mentioned above. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and discuss the proposed project and PARTF conversion. Opportunities to submit written and recorded verbal comments will be provided at the meeting. Comments may also be submitted via phone, email, or mail by July 24, 2017. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
