

**NCDOT TO HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING PROPOSED
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS TO U.S. 70 (GLENWOOD AVENUE)
FROM WEST OF T.W. ALEXANDER DRIVE TO I-540
IN DURHAM AND WAKE COUNTIES
STIP PROJECT U-5518**

The public meeting will take place on Thursday April 6, 2017, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the Flight Room at the Embassy Suites Hotel located at 8001 Arco Corporate Drive in Raleigh. This meeting is being held in an effort to effectively involve the public in the project planning process and the important decisions that will be made regarding the improvements.

NCDOT project U-5518 is proposed to improve U.S. 70 (Glenwood Avenue) from West of T.W. Alexander Drive to Interstate 540 (I-540). This project will also upgrade the at-grade intersections of U.S. 70 with T.W. Alexander Drive and Brier Creek Parkway to interchanges. Several alternatives have been studied and two of those alternatives, that best meet the purpose and need of the project, will be presented.

Maps of the alternatives and a visualization of the project will be available for viewing. An opportunity to discuss the project with NCDOT and Consultant team members, ask questions, and provide feedback will be available. Interested citizens may attend at any time between 4 and 7 p.m. as no formal presentation will be made. Attendees will also have the opportunity to submit written comments and questions until May 6, 2017.
