

**NCDOT TO HOLD TWO PUBLIC MEETINGS REGARDING PROPOSED
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS TO U.S. 70 (GLENWOOD AVENUE)
I-540 IN RALEIGH TO LYNN ROAD IN DURHAM
DURHAM AND WAKE COUNTIES
STIP PROJECT NOS: U-5518 AND U-5720**

Two public meetings will be held to present information on two projects to make improvements to U.S. 70 (Glenwood Avenue) between I-540 and Lynn Road. The meetings will take place on Tuesday, October 30 and Thursday, November 1 between 4 and 7 p.m. The same maps and information will be presented for review at both meetings.

These meetings are being held in an effort to effectively involve the public in the project planning process and the important decisions that will be made regarding the proposed improvements.

Project U-5518: proposes to make improvements to U.S. 70 between T.W. Alexander Drive and I-540. The project also proposes to upgrade current at-grade intersections to either grade-separated roadways (bridges) or interchanges at T.W. Alexander Drive and Brier Creek Parkway.

Project U-5720: proposes to upgrade U.S. 70 to a controlled access roadway, meaning no access will be allowed except at interchanges and intersections between Lynn road in Durham and T.W. Alexander Drive in Raleigh. The project also proposes to convert the at-grade intersection with Sherron Road/South Miami Boulevard to an interchange.

Maps of the alternatives being considered for U-5518 and concepts under development for U-5720 will be available for viewing at both meetings. Maps of the alternatives and concepts are available for viewing and downloading from the NCDOT public meetings website:
